Second booster jabs will be offered to patients aged 75 and over and those at highest risk of severe COVID-19 disease. This follows the latest guidance from the Joint Committee on Vaccination and Immunisation (JCVI).

To protect those cohorts, a spring booster dose will be offered to:

- adults aged 75 years and over
- residents in care homes for older adults
- individuals aged 12 years and over who are immunosuppressed

These individually diverse cohorts have been simplified by NHS-D, as the requirement upon PoC suppliers is to simply allow a second Booster vaccination to be administered to a patient aged 18 years and over with a minimum interval of 91 days, regardless of immunosuppression or risk status.
