[EF-3159] NHSD-ADDEN-0013 - New column for 5-11 year old "not at risk" patients in Incentive Payment Report

The Joint Committee on Vaccination and Immunisation (JCVI) has issued guidance instructing that COVID-19 vaccinations should be offered to children aged 5-11 years who are NOT presently considered to be at clinical risk. As a result, NHS-D have issued an uplift, asking suppliers to include a statistical representation of this cohort within the “incentive payment” section of the reports module.

Eva Health has therefore added a new column to the table within the payments section, as illustrated below. Only patients who have been vaccinated within the date/time range specified, aged between 5 and 11 years (inclusive) and have NOT been recorded as “at risk” within the Screening & Consent template will be included in this column.
